End Times Series- In The Beginning

2 Peter 1:19 ESV “And we have something more sure, the prophetic word, to which you will do well to pay attention **as to a lamp shining in a dark place, until the day dawns...**”

2 Sets of OT Prophecies about the Messiah:

1. Conquering King – who rescues us from our enemies.
2. Suffering Servant – who redeems us from our sins.

The Conquering King – who rescues us from our enemies.

Psalms 2:1-9 ESV Why do the nations rage and the peoples plot in vain? The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the Lord and against his Anointed...Then he will speak to them in his wrath, and terrify them in his fury, saying, "As for me, I have set my King on Zion, my holy hill." I will tell of the decree: The Lord said to me, "You are my Son; today I have begotten you. Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession. You shall break them with a rod of iron and dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel."

The Suffering Servant – who redeems us from our sins.

Isa 53:10-11 ESV “Yet it was the will of the Lord to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the Lord shall prosper in his hand. Out of the anguish of his soul he shall see and be satisfied; by his knowledge shall the righteous one, MY SERVANT, make many to be accounted righteous, and he shall bear their iniquities.”

Rev 1:7 ESV “Behold, he (Jesus) is coming **with the clouds, and every eye will see him**, even those who pierced him, and all tribes of the earth will wail on account of him. Even so. Amen.”

1Thess 4:13-15 ESV “But we do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about those who are asleep, that you may not grieve as others do who have no hope. (14) For since we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so, through Jesus, God will bring with him those who have fallen asleep. (15) For this we declare to you by a word from the Lord, that **we who are alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord**, will not precede those who have fallen asleep.”

James 5:7-8 (NASB) “Therefore be patient, brethren, **until the coming of the Lord**. The farmer waits for the precious produce of the soil, being patient about it, until it gets the early and late rains. You too be patient; strengthen your hearts, **for the coming of the Lord is near.**”

1 John 2:28 ESV “And now, little children, abide in him, so that **when he appears** we may have confidence and not shrink from him in shame **at his coming.**”
